We are glad to inform that as a part of CSR initiative, IMEC has sponsored for construction of 4 Washrooms cum Toilets for new wing at Cheshire Homes Whitefield, a home for elderly and destitute women.



About Cheshire Homes:

Cheshire Homes is a worldwide organization, founded by Group Captain Lord Leonard Cheshire, to support and provide succor to disabled people. The movement has grown from a single Home after World War II to homes in 52 countries. The Cheshire Homes are bound by strict adherence to an international code of integrity, transparency and accountability. Each Home such as the one at Bangalore is a separate entity and responsible for charting its own activities and raising funds.

About Cheshire Homes India, Bangalore (CHIB):

The Old Airport Road Home which is situated opposite Manipal Hospital, it has the capacity to provide care for around fifty disabled girls and women from the weaker section of society. The residences are given free board and lodging, education and medical care including corrective surgeries at the best hospitals. Besides this the residents who are not able to cope with higher studies, are provided Vocational training and opportunities for personal development.

The Whitefield Home is a refuge for elderly women who are cared for and live in dignity during their sunset years. It has the capacity for looking after around 20 disabled / elderly women from the economically weaker section. Presently there are around 25 residents of which 4 are below the age of 60 but are physically disabled and have been residents for long periods and will continue to be with us as they do not have families to fall back on.



As a part of expansion, this home has constructed a dormitory to accommodate 8 more incumbents at the first floor with 4 washrooms cum toilet facility. This new wing has been built only through donations from various Corporate Offices and Individuals. As a part of CSR, IMEC Bengaluru Region sponsored the construction of washrooms cum toilets for this new Wing.
