As a part of CSR initiative, IMEC supported to procure following classroom furniture items for differently – able students of NAB, Sector 5, R K Puram , New Delhi 110 022.

- 40 sets of students' tables/desks for Preparatory, Centre for Multiple Disabilities (CMD) and Inclusive Education (IED).
- 20 Nos. of working table, chair and cupboards for teachers.
- IED works in the afternoon and the furniture is shared between the morning units between Prep & CMD and IED.

About NAB : -

NATIONAL ASSOCIATION FOR THE BLIND (NAB), Delhi is a not-for-profit organisation that came into existence in 1979. NAB Delhi is registered under the Societies Registration Act, 1860, and its a part of the largest network of voluntary organisation serving the visually impaired in India. NAB has 65 branches all over the country including 19 State level Branches. NAB strives to enable the visually impaired lead an independent and dignified life.

Educational Programs of NAB Delhi

- PRE-INTEGRATION UNIT, where NAB develops a young 4 - 7 years old child's sensory and mobility skills to lay a strong foundation and prepare them for mainstream schooling;
- INTEGRATED EDUCATION UNIT, which aims to bring the blind and the sighted children close to each other from an early age, making them aware of each other's unique needs, potentials and strengths, creating better understanding and acceptance. We send our students to mainstream schools to ensure better future prospects and foster inclusion and growth;
- CENTRE FOR MULTIPLE DISABILITIES, where children who have visual impairment along with other disabilities are provided intervention services by a team of dedicated Special Educators, Speech Therapists and other staff;
- STUDY CENTRE FOR DISTANCE LEARNING FOR THE DISABLED: Affiliated to National Institute for Open Schooling and Indira Gandhi National Open University Study Centre.

Objectives - Successful integration in mainstream schools requires to set a strong foundation by preparing children with special skills, such as reading and writing in Braille (Script used by persons with visual disability), and basic concepts of interpersonal skills, mobility skills etc. To achieve this, we at NAB have setup a Preparatory Unit to build the strong foundation, and integrated system of Education (IED unit) to integrate and support the children in mainstream schools.
